In fact, it's an acceptance of an argument based on the emotions and beliefs rather than one based on facts. According to the Oxford Dictionary, "posttruth" is explained "relating to or denoting circumstances which in objectives facts are less inflectional in shaping public opinion than appeals to emotion and personal beliefs." Truth has been decaying and the facts are not based upon the truth. Fake things have appeared in every aspect of life: we see it on social media like Facebook. Twitter. Instagram, etc. The famous British novelist, George Orwell, said: "In times of universal deceit, telling the truth will be a revolutionary act." 
