About the Seminar: -

Post-Truth is contention with public truth's assertion. Post-Truth relates to or exists in an environment in which facts are viewed as irrelevant, or less important than personal beliefs and opinions, and emotional appeals are used to influence public opinion i.e. emotions are more important than knowledge in Post-Truth Phenomenon. In fact, it's an acceptance of an argument based on the emotions and beliefs rather than one based on facts. According to the Oxford Dictionary, "post-truth" is explained as "relating to or denoting circumstances in which objective facts are less influential in shaping public opinion than appeals to emotion and personal beliefs." Truth has been decaying and the facts are not based upon the truth. Fake things have appeared in every aspect of life: we see it on social media like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc. The famous British novelist, George Orwell, said: "In times of universal deceit, telling the truth will be a revolutionary act." This decline of mainstream media and expert knowledge has increased the phenomenon of Post-Truth. Succinctly, it has diminished the role of truth and reason. Post-Truth has led to the decay of political and social norms. The seminar will enable the research scholars to find out the counterproductive atmosphere that derails public discourse and civic engagement.

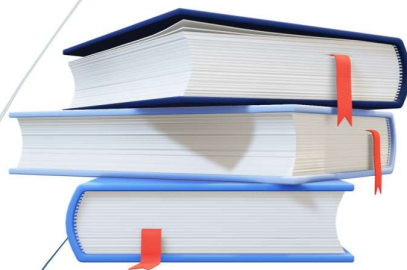
